The Enabling Skills for Life
Programme (ESLP) seeks to equip
persons with disabilities with the
skills to live, learn, work, and
play in the community.

Through more structured programming,` ESLP provides skills training in the domains of independent living, communication, social emotional functioning and vocational training.

ESLP adopts a **person-centred approach** in training to fit each person's unique strengths and needs.

Main Features of ESLP

Person Centric

Support and training are designed to meet the needs of client and his family while leveraging the strengths of the family.

Customised Skills Training

Functional, productive, and vocational skills training delivered according to Individual Development Plan (IDP)*.

*The IDP reflects the client's goals, needs, aspirations, as well as a roadmap for their progression and intervention plans.

Different Support Levels

Greater porosity – client able to access different training pathways in a structured manner as their needs change.

Custodial Care

Provided to clients who may require this support, on top of the training delivered.

Behavioural Intervention

Provided to clients who require this support, to maximise their ability to participate in training delivered.

Caregiver Training

Caregiver will be (i) involved during development of client's IDP, and (ii) equipped to reinforce client's learning in natural settings.



Referral process for ESLP

1. Touch Points (TPs)

Social Service Offices (SSOs), Family Service Centres (FSCs), hospitals, etc.

- TP assesses client's suitability for ESLP
- TP submits ESLP referral to SG Enable

2. SG Enable

Provision of Information and Referral Services

- SG Enable Officer receives application
- SG Enable Officer contacts family to provide information that will help family make an informed decision
- Family decides on an ESLP centre
- SG Enable Officer refers applicant to the ESLP centre of family's choice

3. Service Providers (SPs)

ESLP centres by Social Service Agencies (SSAs)

 SP contacts family to arrange for assessment

For successful applications

 SP will notify family of outcome and follow up on admission procedures

For unsuccessful applications

- SP will notify family of outcome
- SG Enable Officer will refer client to other centres / explore alternatives
