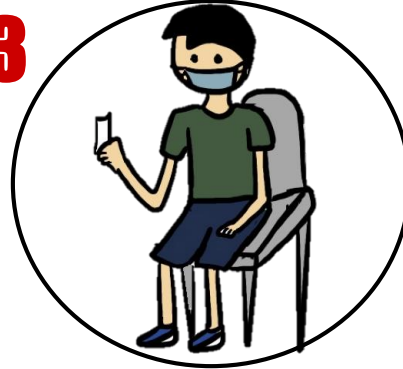

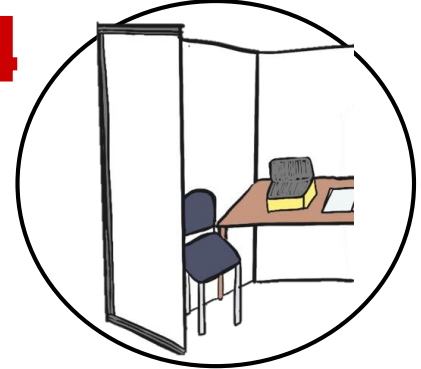

There are many people and noises around me. Mummy/Daddy/My caregiver is with me. I will be okay.



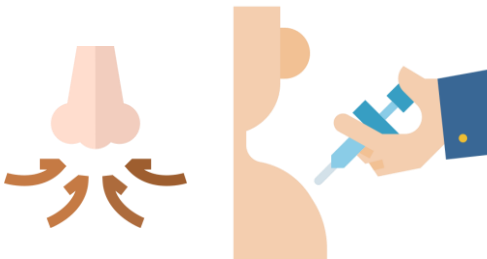
The staff asks questions about me. Mummy/Daddy/My caregiver can help me to answer.



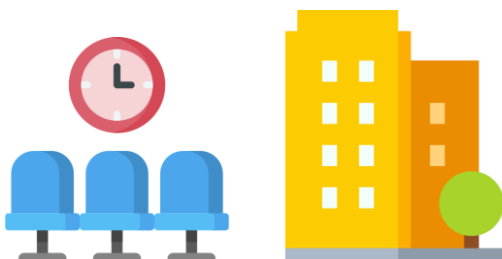
I have to wait for my turn. I can sit nicely with Mummy/Daddy/ my caregiver.

## Social Story: Post Vaccination

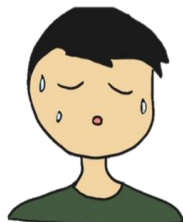
After my jab, I may feel unwell...
